We're delighted to inform you that RFDS Mt Isa has secured additional funding, allowing us to extend our clinic days in Boulia. We now have funding for an additional two clinic days each month for Boulia.

To optimize our clinic services, we've made some adjustments to our schedule. The regular weekly RFDS clinic day will now take place every Tuesday. Additionally, twice a month, we'll be extending our stay in Boulia to two days. On the second day, we've introduced a session specifically for patients requiring extra time, particularly those with underlying chronic diseases.

The other additional days will be dedicated to Indigenous Health, aligning with the Closing The Gap initiative. This day will cater to the Indigenous people of Boulia, addressing chronic diseases or focusing on preventative health assessments.

While these clinics are by invitation only, if you find the need for an appointment on either day, please do let us know – we're eager to accommodate your needs.

Our psychology and mental health services have been adjusted accordingly. Additionally, we now have a nurse practitioner available two days a month.

With the revised clinic schedule, we've also updated the appointment process. You can now schedule appointments with the RFDS doctor, chronic disease nurse, child health nurse, or midwife by calling 07 4745 0434. Although this process may evolve in the future, it's the current and most straightforward way to secure an appointment. Your understanding is greatly appreciated.
